

# 2024 USCIS Filing Fee Changes

## What do I need to know?

- **New USCIS filing fees will go into effect on April 1, 2024.**
- **Some fees will increase, but there will be new discounts for online filings.**
  - USCIS encourages applicants to submit filings online versus paper filings. Online filings will have a reduced application fee. Some examples are:

Application Type	Online	Paper filing
Application to Replace Permanent Resident Card (Form I-90)	\$415	\$460
Petition for noncitizen relative (Form I-130)	\$625	\$675
Application for Employment Authorization (I-765)	\$470*	\$520*
Naturalization Application (Form N-400)	\$710	\$760

- **NOTE: Changes to Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) fees:** The total cost for a DACA renewal filed online will be \$555. For a paper application, the fee will be \$605.
- **Filing fee exemption (no fee!) for all survivor-based categories. This applies to all associated forms, including related applications for lawful permanent residence (“LPR”/”green card”) for the following categories:**

- **T nonimmigrant status** (survivors of trafficking)
- **U nonimmigrant status** (victims of serious crimes)
- **Violence Against Women Act** (abused spouse, child or parent of a US citizen or lawful permanent resident)
- **Special Immigrant Juvenile Status** (youth under 21 who have been abused, abandoned, or neglected by one or both parents)
- **Changes to Naturalization (citizenship application) fees:**
  - Previously, the total cost for most applicants was \$725. Under the new fee rule, applicants who **file online** will be able to pay a reduced amount of **\$710**. People who submit a paper application will pay \$760.
  - The new rule also expands eligibility for **reduced fees for applicants with a household income between 150%-400% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines**. For these applicants, the filing fee will be **\$380**.
- **Other fee increases:**
  - The Advance Parole filing fee for DACA recipients was \$575, and will now be \$630.
  - The Adjustment of Status (“green card”) filing fee for most applicants was \$1,225, and will now be \$1,440.
